COVID-19 MEAL DISTRIBUTION PLAN

The Louisville Metro Senior Nutrition Program operates the federally funded Title IIIC Congregate and Home Delivered meal program throughout the metro area.

COVID-19 PANDEMIC RESPONSE:

Monday, March 16 – All Senior Nutrition sites are CLOSED. Begin Senior Meals Distribution Plan on Tuesday, March 17th.

Congregate meal clients are encouraged to pick up 5-frozen meal packs from the distribution site closest to their usual meal site. (See recommendations below.)

Home-Delivered (“Meals on Wheels”) clients will receive their meal delivery once per week through April 3rd.

Meals on Wheels clients received 5 shelf stable “emergency” meals in December and should use these meals until the first delivery of 5-frozen meals.

Senior Nutrition staff will be calling all homebound clients to inform them of the expected delivery date.

The MARCH for Meals Program is funded through Mayor Fischer and Metro Council to assist seniors with prepared meals during the COVID-19 Pandemic Response.

Senior Meals Distribution Plan:

- For Citizens 60 years of age and older
- Proof of Age is required
- Each eligible adult will be able to receive 1 BOX of frozen meals per week
- Each box has 5 meals and is available first come, first serve
- Up to 1000 meals will be available per day from six rotating meal distribution sites.
