Minutes City of Meadow Vale October 20, 2014

Guests: Police Chief Chapman. Susan Johns came and spoke to the Commission regarding her candidacy for Metro Council. She spoke about issues on Westport Road.

Mayor Hornek called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM.

OPEN MEETING

The September minutes were read, motion to approve with grammatical and spelling changes by Com. Steineker, second by Com. Borders, approved by unanimous vote.

Financial report: Treasurer Lusher presented the City of Meadow Vale September financial report. The report was reviewed. Motion to approve by Com. Borders, second by Com. Prys. Approved by unanimous vote. The bank statements and reconciliations were available for viewing.

LEGAL

Unpaid Taxes: The City Clerk provided a list of outstanding unpaid property taxes from 2013.

Rental Ordinance: We have identified an additional property that has not paid a rental license application fee.

Police Chief Oath: Police Chief Chapman was sworn in by Notary Ritsert. The oath was given by Mayor Hornek.

OLD BUSINESS

Recycling Event: We have identified a couple of potential dates as April 11th or 18th.

Census: Residents have already started turning in the census forms. Many residents have participated. We will be following up with residents who don't submit the forms.

IT Solutions needing Implementation: We have looked at options with Sophicity and Microsoft 360.

NEW BUSINESS

Grants for Signage: The city has an ordinance on the books to charge a \$100 business license fee. We are researching why the city stopped collecting the fees.

City Commission Monthly Activity:

Police Activity: There was an issue with a dog that was left out. Chief has developed a new police schedule that has been provided to Mayor Hornek. Chief is developing new standard operation procedures.

Safety/Special Events: LG&E was called to remove a metal plate that was left after fixing a gas leak at 9816 Meadow Vale Drive. There are a couple of properties that Chief may need to speak to about overgrowth issues.

Streets: The surfacing is completed; they will finish the additional roads in the spring when the weather is warmer.

Drainage & Website: No issues.

Lights & Signs/Social Issues: We have not heard back from the sign company.

Com. Steineker moved to adjourn at 8:21, second by Com. Borders. Unanimously approved.
