Tax Bill Changes

Note from the Clerk –

In your tax bills, I had multiple requests to change names, addresses or ownership information. I don't have any control over that particular information. It is generated by the PVA – Property Valuation Administrator for Jefferson County.

Any property transfers that take place after June 1st will not be recorded in time for the new tax bills and therefore the bills will be sent to the original owner.

You can call the Sheriff's office to request a duplicate (or the city clerk will have a copy of what was sent to the original owner).

To make address changes or for errors – you need to contact the PVA directly.

Reminder—Rental Application

Rental Application Fees are due on January 1st for the 2015 year. The fee is \$200 and the rental application form is available on the City of Meadow Vale website.

As a matter of operating procedure, if your tax bill is not escrowed and your tax bill mailing address is not in the city of Meadow Vale, you may be asked to provide documentation regarding your Meadow Vale residence to show that you do not have rental occupants.

Mayor Hornek called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM.

OPEN MEETING

The October minutes were read, motion to approve with grammatical and spelling changes by Com. Roberts, second by Com. Borders, approved by unanimous vote.

Audit report: Auditor Robert C. Ryan presented the audit report. The City of Meadow Vale accomplished the job of appropriate city money management and met government audit standards. 2013-2014 UFIR has been filed and confirmation received. Commissioner Borders moved to approve the 2013-2014 Audit Report. 2nd by Com. Steineker.

Financial report: Treasurer Lusher presented the City of Meadow Vale October financial report. The report was reviewed. Motion to approve by Com. Steineker, second by Com. Prys. Approved by unanimous vote. The bank statements and reconciliations were available for viewing.

LEGAL

Rental Ordinance/Tax Enforcement: We have identified an additional property that has not paid a rental license application fee.

Business License Fee: Discussion regarding a previous agreement with Goosecreek Properties.

CERS Issue: There is a new attorney that our attorney has contacted to update on details of the arrangement we will revisit.

Code of Ethics Interpretation: Ordinance was discussed.

OLD BUSINESS

Recycling Event: District 17 is going to host an event so we may go with them.

Census: Residents have already started turning in the census forms. Many residents have participated. We will be following up with residents who don't submit the forms.

City Commission Monthly Activity:

Police Activity: Worthington hills might be interested in additional police services.

Safety/Special Events: Date set for June Ice Cream Social: June 6th with 27th as the rain date.

Streets: Street contractor has found another salt supplier. Discussion as to whether we have a specific expectation in terms of amount of snow before we need scraping. Don't plow a second time unless the snow is still falling. No pretreatment. The bill for the surfacing of the streets was \$15000.

Drainage & Website: No issues.

Lights & Signs/Social Issues: The signs were ordered and delivered on November 13. Com. Steineker is considering a NatureScape Grant and she is watching the lights at 2607 Welsford Way and 9808 Boxford Way.

NEW BUSINESS

Realignment of Duties for Commission Beginning 2015: Email Mayor Hornek your interests to realign responsibilities according to interests.

Com. Borders moved to adjourn at 8:32, second by Com. Roberts. Unanimously approved.

No Parking On Street or Grass

The city of Meadow Vale has an ordinance prohibiting parking on the street or grass (Ordinance No. 3, Series 2002-2003)

Kentucky state law also addresses on street parking (KRS: 189.450)
Louisville Metro has an ordinance prohibiting parking on the grass (Metro Code: Chapter 72)

We understand if you have company and need the overflow of vehicles to park on the street for a short period of time. Vehicles should not be parked on the street overnight. These laws will be enforced within our city. They were put into place to protect the safety of our citizens and our property values. Violators of these laws will be fined and subject to towing.
