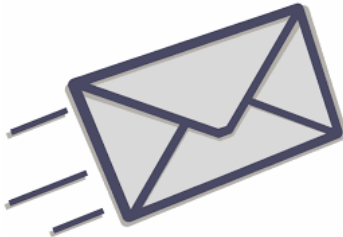

Mayor Hornek called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

**OPEN MEETING**

The July minutes were read, motion to approve with grammatical changes to do by Com. Roberts, second by Com. Steineker, approved by unanimous vote.

Financial report: Treasurer Lusher presented the City of Meadow Vale July financial report. The report was reviewed. Motion to approve by Com. Steineker, second by Com. Roberts. Approved by unanimous vote. The bank statements and reconciliations were available for viewing. Later this week, the auditor will come to the city hall to collect the items that he needs for the audit.

Report from Police Chief :

Mayor's Report: Comm. Roberts, Newman and Mayor Hornek went to code enforcement training on Monday. KLC has samples of letters regarding ordinance violations, etc. Comm. Roberts suggests some standardization to facilitate better alignment by residents.

**LEGAL**Ordinances: Still in process.**OLD BUSINESS**Audit 2014-2015: Auditor will be here on Thursday, he will try to have it back by November.Snow Removal/Berm Maintenance: Trees along Tiverton and Hounz lane – parallel with Hurstborne, are over the sidewalk and need to be trimmed back or cut down.Code Enforcement Board: A board might be worth consideration. A board would require the clerk to take minutes and two residents – cannot be current council members.Census/Surveys/Business License:**City Commission Monthly Activity:****Safety/Special Events:** no report.

**Streets /Signs/Safety:** Com. Newman's report was forwarded to the mayor. He is comfortable with the company from last year. Com. Roberts has suggested a certain path to follow that would be most beneficial. We have had several complaints about Rumpke. Mayor Hornek is going to call about large item pickups and missing cans and rudeness. Busses are speeding through Meadow Vale. Officer Yate will call JCPS. The new police cell number 548-2599. Goose Creek and Somerford will be parking on the street while driveway is getting fixed.

**Drainage & Website:** Commissioner Roberts got an estimate to print 500 directories would be \$379. Office Max/ Depot quoted \$535.30. Com. Roberts was able to get in touch with MSD to come out and meet with her to go around the city and learn more about our drainage issues. MSD has also promised to send out a letter to residents in the drainage areas about their responsibilities for their property.

**Lights/Social Issues:** No issues. Received one call about the missing No Parking On The Street signs. There is one pole by Tiverton that needs painting. There was only one person at the meeting last week. Next meeting is on September 15<sup>th</sup>.

**NEW BUSINESS** No new Business

Com. Steineker moved to adjourn at 8:35, second by Com. Roberts. Unanimously approved.
