**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70 OF THE CITY OF MEADOW VALE
CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO TRAFFIC CONTROL AND VEHICULAR
PARKING FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVISING THE SECTION FOR SPECIAL
VEHICLE PARKING**

WHEREAS, the 2004 Codification of Ordinances mis-interpreted the grandfathered section for special vehicle parking; and

WHEREAS, a committee consisting of a citizen and a commissioner reviewed the need for a revision and have made a proposal.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Meadow Vale, Commonwealth of Kentucky that:

Section 1.

Section 70.35 Traffic Control and Vehicular Parking be amended as follows:

Subsection (B): *Special vehicle parking*. No special vehicle or part of such vehicle of any weight shall be parked or stored on any property zoned single-family residential (R1 through R5), or on the side of any street adjacent to such property in the city unless the special vehicle **and property were owned prior to July 15, 2019. If special vehicle was owned prior to July 15, 2019, it must be:**

- (1) [Is] Stored in a garage, or, if the lot does not contain an adequate garage, then:
- (2) [Is] Stored in the back yard on a hard surface, or if the lot does not have a back yard suitable for parking, then:
- (3) [Is] Stored on the driveway of the home, provided the vehicle does not extend past the front wall of the house
- (4) [~~Was exempted by previous action of the City Commission as provided by previous legislation. *The grandfather exemption is void and of no effect to any subsequent non-conforming vehicles owned by such exempt.] **Special vehicles (not the owner of the special vehicle) in the city as of July 15, 2019 are grandfathered under Subsection (B). However, if the grandfathered special vehicle is sold, junked, traded, totaled, or disposed of in any manner, its replacement will not be allowed to be parked or stored in the city.**~~

Section 2.

All prior ordinances or parts of any ordinance in conflict herein, are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as required by law.
